### SG 8. Initial Scoping Exercise:

One area which had been neglected in some of the initial Neighbourhood Planning process was community engagement, this had caused issues at the Inspection Stage. It was therefore felt vital that a Community Engagement group be formed and that a strategy covering all types of engagement, including digital, be developed at an early stage.

It was also suggested that two members of the Steering Group be assigned to each task group to act as liaison and to take the initial lead.
