MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY MEETING OF THE PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON WEDNESDAY, 9th MARCH 2016, IN THE LUDGVAN OASIS CHILD CARE CENTRE, LOWER QUARTER, LUDGVAN.

Public Participation Period

The meeting was attended by a large number of members of the public, nearly forty, who addressed the Council regarding their concerns about the recent decision to change the School logo. They submitted a petition signed by 433 respondents.

Their primary concerns were a lack of consultation, the failure to take into account the historical significance of the anemone and the inconsistencies in subsequent communications from the School.

The applicant for item 6(f) on the agenda also addressed the Council regarding the associated planning issues.

LPC 466 <u>Minutes of the Monthly Parish Council Meeting on Wednesday 10th February 2016</u> Having been previously circulated the minutes were **approved as a true and correct** record of the meeting and duly signed by the Chairman.

LPC 467 <u>Declarations of interest in Items on the Agenda</u> Councillor D Badcock declared an interest in items 6(d) & (g) and took no part in the discussions.

The Chair agreed to bring forward the agenda item concerning the School logo, having discussed the issue in great detail during the public participation period it was **RESOLVED that the Principal and Chair of the Governors of the School be invited to meet with Councillor Honess and a representative of those members of the public present to discuss the matter.**

LPC 470 <u>Councillor Reports</u>

- (a) Cornwall Councillor Roy Mann reported that Council Tax was due to rise by 3.97% and that there were now only seven public toilets still owned by Cornwall Council.
- (b) The Chair reported that he had attended a meeting regarding the proposed Bay to Bay Cycle Route and it was hoped that public bike hire would be made available at the new or improved toilet facilities in Long Rock and Marazion Station car parks.
- (c) Other members raised the following concern:
 - i. there had been no movement on promised measures to reduce speeds at the Long Rock roundabout;
 - ii. the inordinate delay at the pedestrian crossing in Long Rock prior to the light changing was resulting in people, particularly children, taking a chance and crossing the road before the lights went red;
 - iii. there is still insufficient room for a wheelchair to pass on the corner near Jordan's Cafe in Marazion Station car park;
 - iv. in the same area the road sweepers had swept sand into the drains causing the road to flood.

Councillor Mann and the Clerk undertook to investigate the matters further.
