LPC 506 Apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Councillors C Richards; L Trudgeon

LPC 507 Minutes of the Annual Parish Council Meeting on Wednesday 8th June 2016

Having been previously circulated the minutes were approved as a true and correct record of the meeting and duly signed by the Chairman.

LPC 508 Declarations of interest in Items on the Agenda

Councillor R Mann declared an interest in item 7(c)(i) and took no part in the debate.

LPC 509 <u>Disp</u>ensations

None.

LPC 510 Councillor Reports

- (a) Cornwall Councillor Roy Mann reported the following:
 - i. Litter issues in Long Rock car park had been reported to Cornwall Council and new bins were to be provided.
 - ii. The grass had been trimmed at Crowlas Crossroads but the bank has not been tidied up yet. It was **RESOLVED** that the parish council would repair the bench.
 - iii. Up to 13,500 cars a day go through Lelant village and £6,500 use the 'Coach' Road. This has caused significant delays due to the recent road re-configuration t at Lelant Saltings. The carriageway leading up Nut Lane to the St Erth roundabout is to be widened as a temporary solution.
 - iv. Cornwall Council are investigating setting up a company to deliver social housing.
 - v. Cornwall Council are now the enforcing authority in respect of cars for sale on

verges under new Street Trading Legislation.

(b) Other Councillors:

- i. Councillor Parker reported that the path by the Marazion cafe is now virtually impassable, Councillor Mann agreed to investigate.
- ii. Councillor Hewett asked if there had been any progress in respect of inquiries made about the Trustees of the Canonstown Playing Field as he believed they still lived in the area. Councillor Mann agreed to liaise with him and the relevant Cornwall Council officers.
- iii. Councillor Branchett reported that issues at Long Rock roundabout were yet to be resolved but that preparatory works to repair the sea wall were underway.
- iv. It was **RESOLVED** to purchase the wood necessary to repair seats at Tolverth Field subject to getting the necessary documentation in place.
- v. Councillor Honess reported that works to an entrance in Cockwells Lane had been completed, Councillor Mann stated he had reported the matter to planning enforcement.
- vi. Councillor Hewett reported that numerous for sale signs had appeared at the entrance to Heather Lane and wondered what the views on this might be, the Clerk agreed to report the matter to Highways England in order to find out.
- vii. Councillor Hollow asked whether additional dog bins could be provided, Councillor Mann agreed to pursue the matter.
