# ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD TO 31ST MARCH 2019 TO THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY, 8TH MAY 2019

At the 9th May 2018 Annual Meeting Cllr R Sargeant was nominated and re-elected chairman. Cllr R Mann was elected Vice-Chairman. In November 2018 Cllr Sargeant stood down as chairman and Cllr R Mann was elected chairman in his place.

In the last year Cllrs Badcock, Branchett, Hollow, Honess and Osmand ceased to be members. No Elections were called, the following were co-opted; Cllrs Elliot, Munday, Parker, Price-Jones and Taylor.

The Council has held twelve monthly meetings, plus various committee meetings when required. The 2018/19 Precept was set at £41.414, an increase of £6.927 over the previous year. Balances stood at the year end at £66.315 an increase of £18.027 during the year. Earmarked reserves stood at £34,612.40. The Annual Return will be approved today May 8th, after which it will go to the external auditors.

Donations under regulation S137 of the local government act: We spent a limited sum on good causes in the Parish, a total of £485.00 was awarded.

Allotments are maintained at Long Rock and Church Hill Ludgvan. Most plots are under cultivation. The annual rent was increased to £34.00 in 2019. A waiting list is maintained for both sites. The Council provides prizes for the Ludgvan Horticultural Annual Summer Show.

Our Cemeteries are maintained to a very high standard. In total 7 burials took place; 5 at St Pauls, 2 at Crowlas.

The footpaths maintained in the parish have cost £3,913.00 in the past year. Other maintenance was carried out on the White Cross monument and the British Legion Area on Church Hill. Marazion toilets are now managed by Jordan's Cafe and have been refurbished.

An application has been submitted by Council to address safety issues on Newtown Lane to Marazion Bridge due to speeding and inconsiderate parking.

Planning applications considered by the Council totalled 18 fewer than last year, at 54. The Neighbourhood Plan has reached the Pre-Submission Consultation stage, thanks to Paul Weston and the Development Plan Committee. The Landscape Character Assessment is due to take place later in 2019, supported by the Penwith Landscape Partnership.

Finally my thanks to our clerk Joan Beveridge for supporting me, the council and everything she does for us! Thanks to Henry Rich and Simon Rhodes for their excellent maintenance work. Also to Cllr. Simon Elliott for his Cornwall Council input each month and every councillor for the work they do for the parish!
