Cornwall Council is publishing the following document for a six eek consultation period between 14 August and 5pm 21 September 2020

Draft Marine and Estuarine European Sites Supplementary Planning Document

The SPD is linked to Policy 22 of the <u>Cornwall Local Plan</u>. Plans and policies must not harm the special features of a European site. Habitats Regulations Assessment of the Local Plan concluded that there could be harm to some European Sites in Cornwall due to increased recreation as there will be more people living in Cornwall and so numbers of people using the sites are likely to go up. The SPD sets out a strategic approach to the provision of mitigation and monitoring for increased recreational impacts on designated sites, with a programme of measures and a scale of contributions from development. This makes it easier for developers to make sure that their proposals will not harm a European Site and means that we can use the contributions to help protect the sites.
